Entry Fee & Fundraising

The entry fee is \$10 per bowler:

• \$2 goes to cancer research, \$8 goes to the prize fund, and zero admin fees. Additional fundraising opportunities are available. Upon request, a collection box will

be sent to your center for extra donations.

Prizes & Scholarships

- 1 in 8 participants will win prize money or, for youth, SMART scholarships
- 1st Place (Adult Men & Women): \$300 guaranteed
- 1st Place Youth: \$100 SMART scholarship
- Bowlers may only cash once

Two Ways to Participate

- 1. During Regular League Play:
- Scores must be bowled during scheduled league times
- Submit scores weekly by Saturday through the center's representative
- Pre- and post-bowled scores are not allowed
- Scores will be updated online by the following Tuesday
- Participants can re-enter each week in April during their league(s)
- 2. Set In-House Tournament Squad Times:
 - Centers may host separate tournament squads anytime in April
 - Example: Host a Sunday 10 AM squad charge \$25 (e.g., \$15 lineage + \$10 entry)
 - Want a house prize fund? Try \$12 lineage + \$3 in-house prize fund + \$10 state entry. All prize funds collected will be returned 100%.

Rules & Eligibility

- Averages: Use the highest verifiable 2024–25 fall average (minimum 21 games) as of March 31, 2025
- Handicap: 90% of 230 (no negative handicap)
- The Tournament Director reserves the right to re-rate any bowler
- This is a non-certified USBC event.

Any protests from in-house qualifiers must be submitted in writing to the OSBPA Tournament Director within 24 hours.
