How The Grand Prix Program Works

- ⇒ Register in a youth program at any Grand Prix Bowling Member Center for a \$5 annual fee.
- ⇒ Youth Bowlers earn points by participating in league and bowling center activities. .
- ⇒ Earn additional funding from fundraising activities. Bowlers 2 to age 20 are eligible to participate
- ⇒ Participate in Grand Prix sponsored tournaments for a low entry fee and generous payouts.

Easy to request funds upon graduation

- ⇒ Just fill out a request form with your school enrollment information and email in.
This form and more information is found on OSBPA.com under the Grand Prix tab.
- ⇒ Must be a recognized institution of higher learning within 2 years of graduating.
- ⇒ Checks are written to the school directly within one week of approval
- ⇒ Funds are vested at graduation after 2 consecutive years and \$200 accumulated earned.

The Grand Prix year begins Sept 1 and ends Aug 31st.
