- Eligibility: This tournament is open to all current youth USBC Members who have not yet reached the age of 18 as of 8/1/2024 or are currently enrolled in a High school program.
- Entry fee is \$25.00 per bowler, per event: \$15 lineage, \$0 expenses, and \$10 prize fund.
- Events: This is a singles and/or doubles event bowling 3 games each.
- Bowlers may enter singles only once, and doubles multiple times using a different partner.
- Scholarships are awarded 1 for every 4 entries.
- In case of a tie for 1st or 2nd place scholarships will be divided equally.
- Payouts: Guaranteed min of \$250 1st place awarded on a minimum of 5 bowlers in that Division.
- Averages: Entrants will use the highest verifiable average of 21 or more games as of March 31st, 2024 in all leagues. A standing sheet as of March 31st or USBC average found on bowl.com is required with entry. Sport or Challenge averages will be based on the USBC Conversion chart.
- If a prior year(s) average exceeds 10+ pins difference, the higher of the 2 averages will be used.
- The Tournament Director has the right to rerate or disqualify if rules are not met.
- Falsification of the average may result in disqualification of the bowler.
- Handicap: Individual handicap based on 90% of 220 in all divisions.
- Check-In: 30 minutes prior with preregistration, one hour if not.
- Protests: Any disputes must be made in writing within 24 hours to the Tournament Manager.
- Bowling Attire: Presentable bowling attire only. No tank tops, cut-offs, short shorts/skirts, hats, or headphones permitted. Any violation may result in disqualification.
